FINAL ITINERARY**Day 1: Wednesday, 16 March 2016**

Group to make own transfer arrangements.

It is the responsibility of the Group Leader to ensure all passengers make their own way to the airport and arrive on time.

15:00 hrs Check in at Dublin Airport, Terminal 1 with assistance from an airport representative for **RYANAIR Flight Number FR1901**

17:00 hrs Flight departs

No meals are served on this flight; however snacks and beverages may be purchased on board

20:55 hrs Arrive at John Paul II Balice International Airport (local time)

21:30 hrs You will be met by your coach for transfer to the hotel.

A representative will meet you at the airport to assist with your transfer.

22:30 hrs Anticipated arrival at **Batory Guest Rooms** where the group will spend the next 3 nights with Half Board accommodation. Towels will be provided by the hotel.

Day 2: Thursday, 17 March 2016

08:00 hrs Continental breakfast will be served at the hotel. Lunch to be obtained during the walking tour.

09:00 hrs Confirmed booking for a **half day guided walking tour** of the city.

A guide for Jan Pol will meet the group at the hotel. The tour will cover some/all of the following:

The wartime ghetto of Podgorze and Schindler's Factory (external view only)

Old Town Square

University District

Wawel Hill.

The tour will finish in Kazimierz, the Jewish Quarter which contains several preserved and one working synagogue, a Jewish cemetery and many former civic and public buildings of the old Jewish community.

13:00 hrs Coach to meet the group at the hotel and depart to Wieliczka

14:00 hrs Confirmed guided tour of the **Wieliczka Salt Mine**.

Payment: This visit has been pre-paid. No voucher is required.

Further Information:

It is recommended to wear warm clothing as the mines are cold even during the summer (between 14° C and 16° C).

Please wear comfortable shoes, the journey begins with a descent down the Danilowicz Shaft to Level I of the mine. It is situated 64 m underground, walking down 380 stairs. The next levels lead the tour even deeper, i.e. 135 m underground. There are 800 steps along the whole route. After a short respite, visitors go up to the surface in a mining elevator

Toilet facilities are located on the surface adjacent to the shaft and again at approx. 40 mins and 90 mins into the tour.

Taking photographs requires a special permit which may be purchased in the ticket office or during the visit itself. The permit price is PLN 10

16:30 hrs Return to the hotel on the coach.

18:00 hrs Evening meal will be served at the hotel.

Day 3: Friday, 18 March 2016

07:00 hrs Continental breakfast will be served at the hotel. Packed lunches will be provided in lieu of the missed evening meal from 16/03/2016.

08:00 hrs Depart for Auschwitz by coach. Please be prompt - admission procedures at Auschwitz have changed and groups arriving late will be denied entrance, even if the delay was beyond their control. We have therefore allowed a longer journey time from Krakow to allow for traffic delays etc.

10:30 hrs Approximate time of arrival for a confirmed guided tour of **Auschwitz-Birkenau** in English. The tour will begin and will last up to 3 ½ hours and will include:

• **Standard Tour (maximum 3.5 hour tour):**

Tour of the permanent exhibitions and buildings at the Auschwitz I-Main Camp and the most important original camp buildings in Auschwitz II-Birkenau: prisoner barracks, the unloading platform (ramp), and the ruins of gas chamber and crematoria II or III. This tour does not include the "Central Sauna"

Further information:

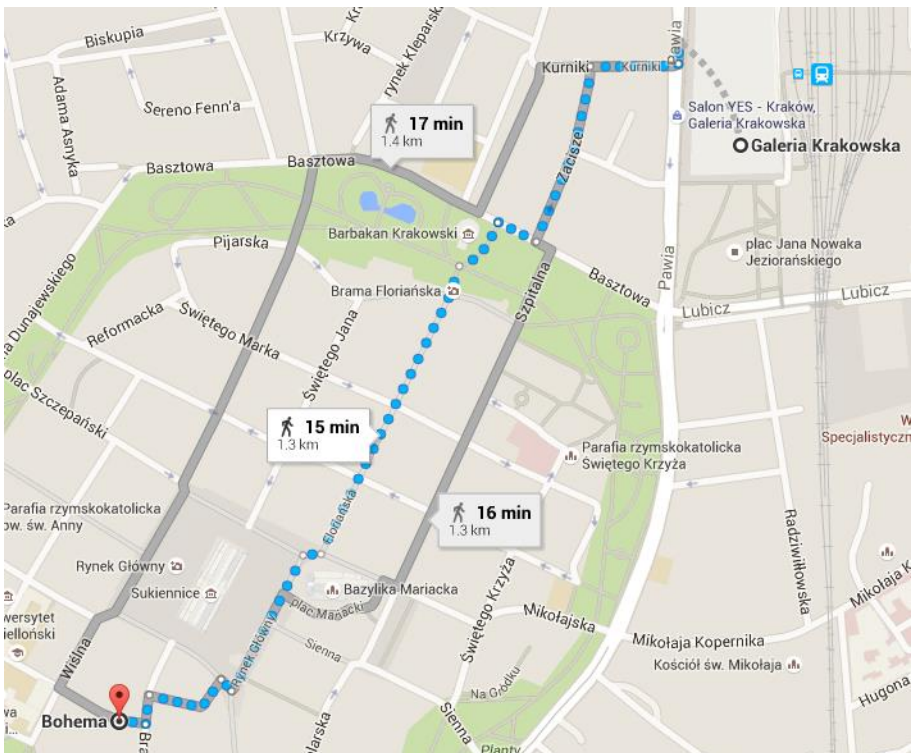
-Please note it is not permitted for groups to stay on the territory of Auschwitz I or Auschwitz II-Birkenau without their guide.

- There is a 20 minute film on the liberation of Auschwitz Camp which can be viewed as an optional extra. There is an additional cost of 4 Zloty per person and this must be paid direct to the Visitor Reception Point- it is not possible to pre-pay.

- *The maximum size of bag which may be taken on site is 30x20x10 cm. Any bags larger than this should be left on the coach. Alternatively, baggage storage is available for a fee in the Visitor Service Centre. The museum guards may ask for small bags being taken on site to be opened for inspection.*

14:00 hrs Depart on the coach and return to Krakow. The group will be dropped off at Galeria Krakowska shopping mall for some down time.

18:30 hrs Depart on foot to the Bohema Restaurant.

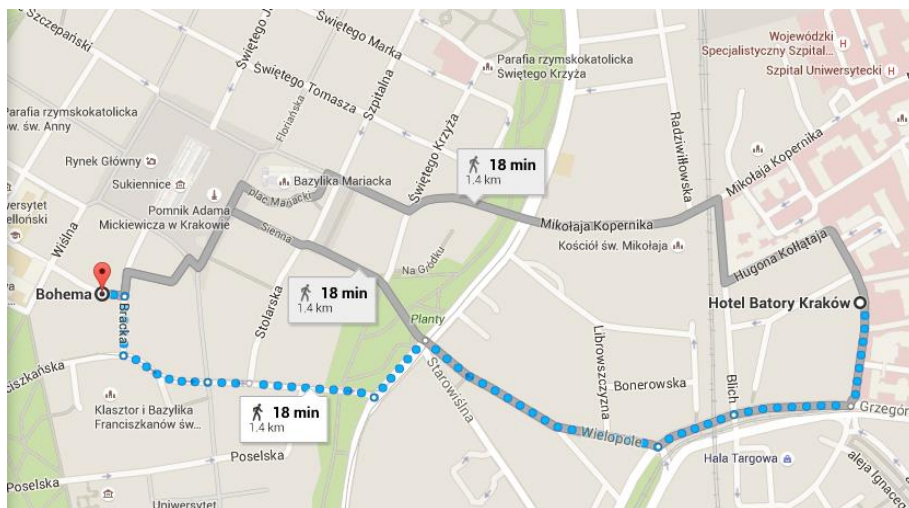

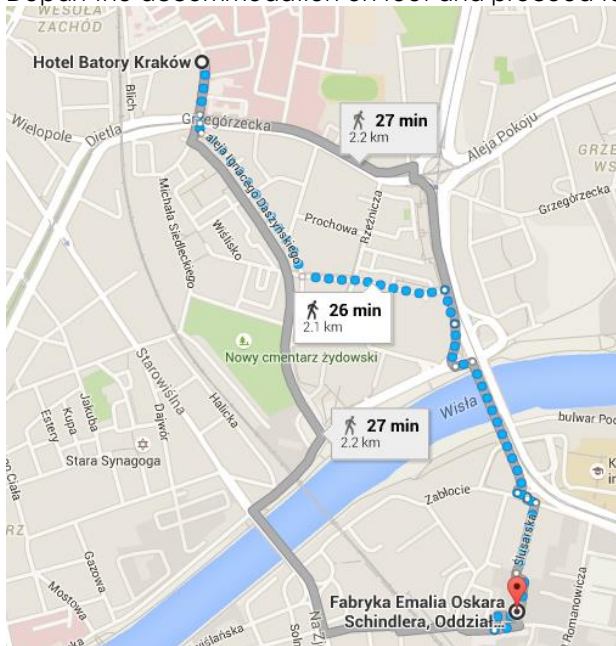

Confirmed guided tour at the **Schindler Factory Museum**. The group will divide into **3** parties for admission.

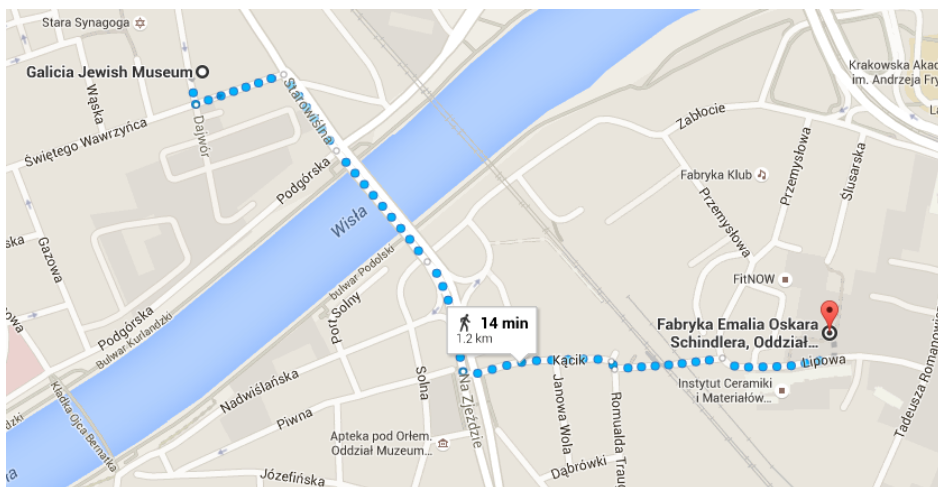
